We recommend a visit of at least four hours to fully experience Castle life at Warwick Castle. However, we have also put together a range of itineraries designed for shorter visits.



The State Rooms and Gardens Tour

Experience the grandeur of Britain's Ultimate Castle. Tour the Great Hall and State Rooms and visit the formal gardens and Capability Brown landscaped grounds.

Don't miss:

- ✦ **The Great Hall** The historic heart of the Castle
- ✦ **Chapel** Built in the 1600s on the orders of Sir Fulke Greville
- ✦ **Staterooms** Home to the Castle's most prestigious possessions
- ✦ **Henry VIII Meet Henry** and all his wives!
- ✦ **The Mound** Built on the orders of William the Conqueror in 1068
- ✦ **Rose Garden** First laid in 1868 and home to the 'Warwick Castle' Rose
- ✦ **Conservatory** Ornamental glasshouse with exotic plants
- ✦ **Peacock Garden and Pageant Field** Classic 'Capability Brown'



The Castle Dungeon Tour

Experience the darker side of Warwick Castle with a tour through the Castle Dungeon where live actors and special effects bring the Castle's history vividly to life. Finish the tour by visiting the Castle's towers and ramparts.

Don't miss:

- ✦ **Castle Dungeon Tour** Live actors and special effects bring the story to life. Note: Castle Dungeon tours must be booked in advance
- ✦ **Towers and Ramparts** Explore the defensive genius of the Castle

The Gardens Tour

Explore the grand gardens and landscapes surrounding Warwick Castle including 'Capability' Brown's first independent commission. The self guided tour takes in the formal gardens, riverside and mill and the Rose Garden.

Don't miss:

- ✦ **The Mound** Built on the orders of William the Conqueror in 1068
- ✦ **Rose Garden** First laid in 1868, home to the 'Warwick Castle' Rose
- ✦ **Conservatory** Ornamental glasshouse with exotic plants
- ✦ **Peacock Garden** Home to the Castle's own ostentation of Peacocks
- ✦ **The Pageant Field** Classic 'Capability Brown' landscapes and views
- ✦ **River and Island** Cross the River Avon for stunning Castle views
- ✦ **The Mill** A fully restored mill and engine house
