

# The Princess Tower



## Summary

- The Princess Tower hosts princess story time for 3- to 8-year-olds.
- Entry is via free timed tickets, which can be collected from our Princesses at the base of the tower.
- The Tower is, unfortunately, not accessible to wheelchair users and may be problematic for young guests with mobility issues.
- Should a child not be able to access the Storytime itself then one of the loving princesses will be happy to come down to spend some quality time with them.

## Stepped Entrance



- There are 12 steps to climb to the entrance of the tower.
- Once through the door there is a photo Opportunity
- There are 25 steps of a spiral staircase to climb to wishing tree room.



## Wishing Tree and Story Rooms



- Both of these rooms have step free access.
- There is also step free access to the photo collection area.
- There is good lighting in all areas.
- Sound levels on voice overs are at a very comfortable spoken speech volume.
- Children enjoy the story while seated on a carpet.
- There is a challenge where children are asked to find important things for the princess.

## Exit



- Groups exit into Daisy's corridor.
- There is light background music in this area.
- Exit to the castle courtyard is via a spiral staircase with 32 steps
- There is a handrail on the right-hand side.
